Cre8 Surplus Food Grocery

Grocery visitors top over 200 per week. As the cost of living crisis starts to affect families cross our community we've seen an increase in those using our surplus food grocery with visitor numbers now regularly topping over 200.

The grocery which is open to anyone, operates three times per week. Tuesday and Wednesday at St Barnabas on Lyme Avenue and Thursday at Green on the Corner Cafe on the Hurdsfield. Visitors make a £3 Donation in return receive up to £20 worth of food.


