Cre8 Youth Clubs - Jeremy's Story

Jeremy [named changed] joined Cre8 this September; coming along to our Primary-age youth club on a Wednesday night. Jeremy has behavioural and emotional needs, he has involvement with social care and currently lives with relatives, not his parents. Jeremy has suffered from past trauma which leaves him vulnerable and withdrawn, he attends CAMHS on a regular basis to gain help with issues raised from the past. Jeremy is shy and struggles to interact with his peers, occasionally becoming aggressive through frustration. Since joining Cre8, his guardian has spoken of the improvement in Jeremy's social skills and how positive his relationships have been with his peers during youth club. Jeremy hasn't show any behavioural issues at Cre8 and joins in most activities that he feels comfortable with. Jeremy's team won a quiz night one week and the confidence was clear to see when he was leaving club that

night. Jeremy always joins in the meal and is gaining confidence when socialising over food at the end of the night.
